AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE
AGREEMENT WITH TECTONICS ARCHITECTS, PLANNERS
AND ENGINEERS FOR THE MISSION BEACH LIFEGUARD
STATION.

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2003, the City of San Diego executed an agreement with TECTONICS Architects, Planners & Engineers (TECTONICS) for design of the upgrade of the Mission Beach Lifeguard Station (Project), which includes alterations and additions to increase the locker room capacity, provide separate male and female locker rooms, and a unisex accessible restroom and storage area, for \$32,993.40, a copy of which agreement is on file as Document No. C-12437 (Agreement); and

WHEREAS, the Project had been on hold due to lack of funding but now funds to complete the Project are available; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have TECTONICS update the project plans in order to comply with changes in the building codes, finalize the plans and specifications, provide support during construction, and to prepare the as-built drawings; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of said City, an amendment to the Agreement with TECTONICS in the amount of \$15,000 for the purpose of completing the design phase in CIP #S-00793, Mission Beach Lifeguard Station, under the terms and conditions set forth in the document on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 20030.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$15,000 from Fund CIP #S-00793, Mission Beach Lifeguard Station, Fund 400624, Deferred Maintenance 2009A-Project, for the purpose of executing the amendment to the Agreement, contingent upon the City Comptroller first certifying funds are available.


Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
