AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-19976 (NEW SERIES) ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2011 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO INCREASE THE FIRE-RESCUE DEPARTMENT BUDGET BY UP TO \$152,520 DOLLARS FROM FUNDS PROVIDED BY THE UC REGENTS TO RESTORE LIFEGUARD SERVICE AT BLACK'S BEACH.

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2010, the City Council adopted San Diego Ordinance No. O-19976, An Ordinance Adopting The Annual Budget For The Fiscal Year 2011 And Appropriating The Necessary Money To Operate The City Of San Diego For Said Fiscal Year (Fiscal Year 2011 Appropriation Ordinance); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor proposed a budget revision to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a hearing on March 8, 2011 and on March 14, 2011 to consider the budget revision; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution R- 06686 revising the budget as proposed by the Mayor without any changes; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2011 Appropriation Ordinance is necessary to authorize the Chief Financial Officer to increase the Fire-Rescue Department (Dept. 1912) budget by \$152,520 from funds provided by the Regents of the University of California to restore lifeguard service at Black's Beach; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter section 280(a)(4), the Mayor has no veto power over this ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Fiscal Year 2011 Appropriation Ordinance is hereby amended consistent with Resolution R- 06687 to authorize the Chief Financial Officer to increase the Fire-Rescue Department (Dept. 1912) budget by \$152,520 from funds provided by the Regents of the University of California to restore lifeguard service at Black's Beach.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to take effect and be in force immediately upon passage pursuant to the authority contained in San Diego Charter sections 71, 275, and 295.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.
