AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-19976 (NEW SERIES) ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2011 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO APPROPRIATE AND EXPEND FUNDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MID-YEAR REVISIONS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2011 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2010, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. O-19976, entitled "An Ordinance Adopting the Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 2011 and Appropriating the Necessary Money to Operate the City of San Diego for Said Fiscal Year" (Appropriation Ordinance); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has proposed certain revisions (Mid-Year Revisions) to the budget for the Fiscal Year commencing July 1, 2010, and ending June 30, 2011 (2011 Budget); and

WHEREAS, on March 2, 2011, the City Council caused a hearing to be held before the City Council's Budget and Finance Committee to consider the proposed Mid-Year Revisions to the 2011 Budget; and

WHEREAS, on March <u>32</u>, 2011, the City Council held a second public hearing to consider the proposed Mid-Year Revisions to the 2011 Budget, in accordance with San Diego City Charter sections 71 and 290; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has passed Resolution R306711, approving the Mid-Year Revisions to the 2011 Budget as proposed by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Appropriation Ordinance is necessary to authorize

expenditures related to certain of the Mid-Year Revisions to the 2011 Budget; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to sections 280(a)(4) and 290(d) of the San Diego Charter, the Mayor has no veto power over this ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Appropriation Ordinance is hereby amended to authorize the Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and expend funds in accordance with the Mid-Year Budget Revisions and Resolution R-306711

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to take effect and be in force immediately upon passage after two public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 71, 275, and 295 of the Charter of the City of San Diego.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.
