

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 20064 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 07 2011

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-19976 (NEW SERIES) ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2011 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO APPROPRIATE AND EXPEND FUNDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE YEAR-END REVISIONS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2011 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2010, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. O-19976, entitled "An Ordinance Adopting the Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 2011 and Appropriating the Necessary Money to Operate the City of San Diego for Said Fiscal Year" (Appropriation Ordinance); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has proposed certain revisions (Year-End Revisions) to the budget for the Fiscal Year commencing July 1, 2010, and ending June 30, 2011 (2011 Budget); and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2011, the City Council held a public hearing to consider the proposed Year-End Revisions to the 2011 Budget; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2011, the City Council held a second public hearing to consider the proposed Year-End Revisions to the 2011 Budget, in accordance with San Diego Charter sections 71 and 290; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has passed Resolution R-306837 approving the Year-End Revisions to the 2011 Budget as proposed by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Appropriation Ordinance is necessary to authorize expenditures related to certain of the Year-End Revisions to the 2011 Budget; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to sections 280(a)(4) and 290(d) of the San Diego Charter, the Mayor has no veto power over this ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Appropriation Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. To authorize the Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and expend funds in accordance with the Year-End Budget Revisions and Resolution R- 306837

Section 2. To authorize the Chief Financial Officer to transfer appropriations between General Fund departments as necessary where the net transfer does not result in an increase to either department's current budget.

Section 3. To authorize the Chief Financial Officer to increase the Information Technology Fund expenditure appropriations in order to transfer fund balance to the Wireless Communications Technology Fund.


Section 4. To authorize the Chief Financial Officer to adjust appropriations for unforeseen events in order to close Fiscal Year 2011 with departments and funds in balance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance is declared to take effect and be in force immediately upon passage after two public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 71, 275, and 295 of the Charter of the City of San Diego.
