AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF THE
CONTRACT WITH KONICA MINOLTA BUSINESS
SOLUTIONS FOR THE RENTAL OF CONVENIENCE
COPIERS AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF
FUNDS

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2005, the City Council authorized the City to execute a contract with Konica Minolta Business Solutions (Konica) to provide convenience copiers for use by the City pursuant to Resolution No. R-300650; and

WHEREAS, the contract with Konica will expire on August 22, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of advertising and awarding a new contract for convenience copiers, but it is unlikely that a new contract will be in place before the current contract expires; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to extend the duration of the current contract with Konica for the rental of convenience copiers from August 22, 2011 to December 31, 2011 or until a new contract is awarded, whichever occurs first, at rates not to exceed those in the existing contract.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$700,000 from Fund No. 720041, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the extension to the contract.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.


