AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE FIFTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH DOKKEN ENGINEERING, INC. FOR THE STATE ROUTE 163/FRIARS ROAD PROJECT IN MISSION VALLEY.

WHEREAS, the proposed project would provide for the modifications of State Route 163 and the Friars Road Interchange in order to optimize traffic circulation within the interchange area, and this Fifth Amendment to the Agreement would provide for the preparation of Plans, Specifications, and Estimate for the construction of Phase 1 ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the scope of work for the Project includes the widening of Friars Road from Avenida De Las Tiendas to Mission Center Road, including the bridge over State Route 163, improvements to Frazee Road and Avenida De Las Tiendas, coordination of signal timing through Friars Road corridor, removal of the existing Northbound to Eastbound off-ramp, reconstruction of Southbound and Northbound loop off-ramps, construction of an interim Southbound SR-163 auxiliary lane, construction of soundwalls, bike lanes and sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Fifth Amendment to the Agreement with Dokken Engineering, Inc. is required to provide engineering services for the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute, for and on behalf of said City, the Fifth Amendment to the Agreement with Dokken Engineering, Inc. for design services for CIP S-00851, State Route 163/Friars Road, for the purpose of completing

Phase 1 of the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$3,753,300 under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-~~20115~~

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$2,753,300 from CIP S-00851, State Route 163/Friars Road, Fund 400135 (Mission Valley-Urban), and \$1,000,000 from CIP S-00851, State Route 163/Friars Road, Fund 400169, (TransNet), for the purpose of executing the Fifth Amendment for the above-referenced Project.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
