WHEREAS, the Human Relations Commission (Commission) is established in San Diego Municipal Code section 26.0905, to advise the Mayor and City Council on the rights of every inhabitant of the City of San Diego to equal economic, political and educational opportunity; to equal accommodations in all business establishments in the City; and to equal service and protection by public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the Commission is comprised of fifteen members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, all of whom are required to be residents of the City of San Diego unless the requirement is otherwise waived by the City Council pursuant to Council Policy 000-13; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code also provides that the membership of the Commission shall consist of seven members appointed by the Mayor and eight additional members, one each from a list of up to three nominations submitted by each Councilmember; and

WHEREAS, the members shall serve for a term of four years, except that all vacancies occurring during a term shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the following reappointments by the Mayor of the City of San Diego to serve as members of the Human Relations Commission, for the term ending as indicated, be and the same are hereby confirmed:
