A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO APPROVING CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND
TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE GENERAL
REQUIREMENTS CONTRACT S11 SITEWORK

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the contract documents and specifications for the construction of General Requirements Contract S11 Sitework [Project], as advertised by the Purchasing and Contracting Department, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR 306603, are approved.

2. That, after advertising for bids in accordance with law, the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to award the Project contract to the lowest responsible and reliable bidder in an amount not to exceed \$4,500,000, provided that the City Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for the expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend funds in an amount not to exceed \$4,500,000 for two years with a minimum contract guarantee of \$50,000 from various funding sources for the purpose of providing funds for the Project and related costs, provided that the City Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

4. That the City Comptroller is authorized, upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
