A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A COOPERATIVE HYDROGEOLOGIC INVESTIGATIONS AGREEMENT WITH UNITED STATES GEOLOGICAL SURVEY.

WHEREAS, on December 9, 2002, the City Council adopted the Long-Range Water Resources Plan [LRWRP] which established a goal of developing 10,000 acre-feet per year and storing up to 20,000 acre-feet of local groundwater by 2010 to become less reliant on imported water; and

WHEREAS, to help achieve the goals of the LRWRP and to comply with state law, the
United States Geological Survey [USGS] will install four monitoring wells, two in the San Diego
Formation and two in the San Pasqual Basin; and

WHEREAS, the USGS hydrogeologic investigation will assist the City by providing the data and analysis of hydrogeologic and water quality information to better understand these basins and develop them sustainably; NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a joint funding agreement with USGS for the Cooperative Hydrogeologic Investigations of the San Diego Formation and the San Pasqual Basin [Agreement], in CIP A-BM.00001, Annual Allocation - Groundwater Asset Development Program (B-11065 and B-11066), in an amount not to exceed \$1,756,000, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, on file with the City Clerk as Document No. RR 306613

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized expend an amount not to exceed \$1,756,000 from CIP A-BM.00001, Annual Allocation – Groundwater Asset Development Program (B-11065 and B-11066), Fund 700011, Water, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the above Agreement, provided that the Chief Financial Officer furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure under established contract funding phases are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
