A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF FUNDS AND THE EXPENDITURE OF THESE FUNDS FOR THE IMPERIAL AVENUE STREET LIGHTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Imperial Avenue Street Light Project includes the installation of 20 street lights along Imperial Avenue between 61st Street and 69th Street and had an original estimated budget of \$210,000; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the creation of the original estimated budget project, complications related to the proximity of the project to Metropolitan Transit System rail lines including additional permitting, and insurance requirements have become known; and

WHEREAS, due to these additional project requirements the estimated project budget has increased to \$285,000; and NOW, THEREFORE;


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to transfer appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$75,000 from CIP S-00829, Paradise Hills Revitalization Project, Fund No. 400156 TransNet, to CIP S-00983, Imperial Avenue Street Lights – from 61st to 69th Streets.

2. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$75,000 from CIP S-00983, Imperial Avenue Street Lights – from 61st to 69th Street, Fund No. 400156 TransNet, is authorized, solely and exclusively for the purpose of constructing streetlights on Imperial Avenue, provided that the City Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

3. That the City Comptroller, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
