WHEREAS, on November 29, 2004, the City Council created the Parking Advisory Board by adopting an ordinance that is on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. O-19337 and codified at San Diego Municipal Code sections 26.1801, 26.1802, and 26.1803; and

WHEREAS, the Parking Advisory Board serves as an advisory body to the Mayor and City Council on policy issues relating to parking; and

WHEREAS, the Parking Advisory Board is comprised of seventeen members who serve two-year terms and until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed; and

WHEREAS, the members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance requires the Mayor to appoint one at-large member; eight members from a list of two nominations submitted by each Councilmember; one member from each Community Parking District; one member from the Community Planning Committee; and one member from the Business Improvement District Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following appointments by the Mayor of the City of San Diego to serve as members of the Parking Advisory Board be and the same are hereby confirmed:
