A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH RON'S MAINTENANCE FOR CATCH BASIN CLEAN OUT AND CURB INLET INSPECTION AND CLEANING WITH FOUR (4) ONE-YEAR OPTIONS TO RENEW.

WHEREAS, in January 2007, the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) issued NPDES Order No. 2007-0001 which permits and places conditions on the City's discharge of storm water from its storm water conveyance system; and

WHEREAS, provisions in the permit require inspection and maintenance activities to verify proper operation of all municipal structural treatment controls designed to reduce pollutant discharges to or from its storm drain system and related drainage structures; and

WHEREAS, the RWQCB requires that the City implement a schedule of maintenance activities and inspections at least once a year between May 1 and September 30 for all storm drain facilities that receive or collect high volumes of trash and debris; and

WHEREAS, in order to address these permit requirements as well as other maintenance needs, the City issued Invitations for Bids No. 9260-08-B calling for bids to provide catch basin and curb inlet and inspection cleanout services, specifying 24,000 storm drain inlets to be cleaned, inspected, and maintained with additional costs for disposals of special waste; and

WHEREAS, Ron's Maintenance was the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the services provided under this contract provide equipment and staffing over and above the current levels in the Storm Water Department; and

WHEREAS, at the City Council meeting on January 11, 2011, regarding the City's contract with Ron's Maintenance, a Councilmember asked whether City employees can perform the work being done by Ron's Maintenance; and

WHEREAS, a representative of the City's Storm Water Department responded that City staffing levels do not allow the City to inspect and maintain all of the City's drainage structures each year as required by the NPDES Order; and

WHEREAS, following the January 11, 2011, meeting, the City's Labor Relations staff engaged representatives of the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, Local 127 (AFSCME Local 127), in discussions regarding the Ron's Maintenance contract; and

WHEREAS, as a result of these discussions, AFSCME Local 127 has stated that it is not opposed to ratification of the Ron's Maintenance contract for the work that has already been performed as well as the work needed to be performed to fulfill NPDES Order requirements in calendar year 2011, so long as City management explore whether City employees can perform the work in future years and engage AFSCME Local 127 in future discussions on this matter; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute a contract with Ron's Maintenance for catch basin cleanout and curb inlet inspection and cleaning per Bid No. 926608-B, Contract Number CO 08100189, executed under the Mayor's authority on May 1, 2008, for one year with four (4) one-year options to renew with maximum allowable price increases not to exceed the Consumer Price Index or 5% for each option year, on file with the City Clerk as Document No. RR 306675.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed

\$364,000 from Fund 100000, General Fund, to fulfill the contract amount not to exceed \$700,000

for the purpose of catch basin cleanout and curb inlet inspection/cleaning in calendar year 2011.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed

\$771,750 in Fiscal Years 2011 and 2012 from Storm Water Department 2114, General Fund

100000 for catch basin cleanout and curb inlet inspection and cleaning only as needed to fulfill

NPDES Order requirements in calendar year 2011, contingent on such funds being included in

Fiscal Years 2011 and 2012 appropriation ordinances and provided that the City Comptroller

furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds are, or will be, on deposit with

the City Treasurer.

4. That the City Comptroller is authorized to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any,

to the appropriate reserves on advice from the administering department.
