A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CALTRANS) FOR TRANSPORTATION PLANNING GRANT.

WHEREAS, Caltrans has established the California Transportation Planning Grant
Program which includes Community-Based and Environmental Justice grants to provide state
funding for transportation-related planning activities to engage the community efforts to improve
mobility, access, and economic vitality; and

WHEREAS, four transportation planning project applications have been prepared requesting a total of \$1,000,000 in state funding; and

WHEREAS, the following four planning studies are proposed to be submitted to Caltrans by the March 30, 2011 deadline: the 30th Street Corridor Mobility Study, the Downtown Green Streets Study, the Morena Boulevard Station Area Study, and the National Avenue Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the 30th Street Corridor Mobility Study proposes an extensive public outreach effort, mobility assessment and mobility plan for the 30th Street corridor from Adams Avenue to SR-94; and

WHEREAS, the Downtown Green Streets Study will generate design concepts for a future implementation phase; and

WHEREAS, the Morena Boulevard Station Area Study would seek to provide a vision for the areas surrounding the respective Mid-Coast trolley stations in an effort to create destinations for people to live, shop, and work near the stations; and

WHEREAS, the National Avenue Master Plan would provide guidance for roadway,

sidewalk, and streetscape improvements to enhance multimodal mobility and safety for

pedestrian, bicyclists, automobile drivers, and transit riders, and would also include land use and

urban design recommendations along National Avenue from I-5 to 43rd Street; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. The Mayor or his representative is authorized to make an application to California

Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and to take all necessary actions to secure funding for

an amount up to \$1,000,000 in Transportation Planning Funds for transportation planning

projects.

2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept up to \$1,000,000 if the grant

funding is secured.

3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing

account, if required.

4. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend up to

\$1,000,000 for the purpose of transportation planning, contingent upon receipt of a fully

executed grant agreement.
