A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE BUS STOP IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2008 the San Diego City Council adopted R-304026, approving an agreement (Agreement) with Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) regarding revenue derived from the sale of advertising on bus benches and bus shelters; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Agreement the City will in Fiscal Year 2011 receive \$94,704.03 in bus shelter and bus bench advertising revenue from MTS; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that these funds be used for capital improvements in the vicinity of bus shelters and bus benches; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Fiscal Year 2011 Capital Improvements Program Budget for CIP

  A-ID.00007, Annual Allocation Bus Stop Improvements, Fund 400691- Bus Stop Capital

  Improvements is amended by increasing the budget amount by \$94,704.03.
- 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$94,704.03 from CIP A-ID.00007, Annual Allocation Bus Stop Improvements, solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for bus stop improvements, provided that the City Compfroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the fimds necessary for expenditures are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

6. That the City Compfroller, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
