DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 11 2011

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING THE TERMINATION OF A CONTINUED STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE TIJUANA RIVER VALLEY DUE TO THE POTENTIAL FOR SEVERE FLOODING.

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 8630 authorizes local governing bodies to proclaim local emergencies when such events occur as are defined by California Government Code section 8558(c); and

WHEREAS, Section 8630 further provides that the local governing body review the need for continuing the local emergency at least once every thirty days until the governing body terminates the local emergency; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number R-305256 passed on September 23, 2009, the City of San Diego declared the existence of a state of emergency related to the potential for severe flooding in the Tijuana River Valley; and

WHEREAS, Government Code setion 8630(d) requires that a governing body shall proclaim the termination of the local emergency at the earliest possible date that conditions warrant.

WHEREAS, the potential for severe emergency flooding in the Tijuana River Valley has been reduced;

WHEREAS, notwithstanding that conditions of immediate peril have subsided, the hydrological impacts of the federal Tactical Border Infrastructure (TBI) project remain unknown and possibly unmitigated, the Tijuana River Valley remains a flood control priority area; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that pursuant to California Government Code section 8630(d), the state of emergency previously declared by Resolution Number R-305256 to persist relative to the potential for severe flooding in the Tijuana River Valley is hereby declared terminated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that because possibly significant and unmitigated hydrological impacts of the federal TBI project remain unstudied, and thus uncertainty exists for the planning of flood control in the Tijuana River Valley, the Mayor, or his designee, is requested to maintain vigilance over the capacity of drain channels in the valley and to take reasonable actions to prepare for continued maintenance of the channels notwithstanding the termination of the emergency declaration.
