A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING GRANT APPLICATION FOR TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR THE SAN DIEGO INTERTIE FEASIBILITY STUDY.

WHEREAS, the San Diego Intertie Feasibility Study is a proposed partnership by

Memorandum of Understanding [MOU] between the City's Public Utilities Department

[Department], the Sweetwater Authority and the US Bureau of Reclamation to explore the

potential benefits of expanding conveyance capacity between three key reservoirs owned by the

City of San Diego and two reservoirs owned by the Sweetwater Authority; and

WHEREAS, the analysis will examine the various intertie configurations in terms of feasibility, operational benefits and affordability, taking into consideration new and anticipated water supply operations within the San Diego region for both imported and local water supplies; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, a MOU agreement and all necessary amendments thereto, with the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation and Sweetwater Authority for the implementation of the San Diego Intertie Feasibility Study [Project] under the terms and conditions set forth in the MOU agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-306808

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2. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and empowered for and on behalf

of the City to make an application to the State of California for Proposition 50 State Grant

Funding for the Project.

3. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and empowered to take all

necessary actions to secure Proposition 50 State Grant Funding from the State of California for

up to \$782,244.00 for the Project.

4. That the City Comptroller is authorized to set up a Proposition 50 State Grant

Funding grant number, accept, appropriate and expend funds not to exceed \$782,244.00 in FY

2012, FY 2013 and FY 2014 in Fund 710001 Grant Fund-Entrprse-State, if grant funding is

secured.

5. That the MOU agreement between the City of San Diego, Sweetwater Authority

and the Bureau of Reclamation is approved.

6. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department,

is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
