DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 24 2011

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING OPTION YEARS 3, 4 AND 5 TO DOWNSTREAM SERVICES, INC. CONTRACT FOR CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISIONING INSPECTION OF SEWER MAINS AND MANHOLES, AND RELATED ACTIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:


1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to extend the existing contract with Downstream Services, Inc. for closed circuit televising inspection (CCTV) of sewer mains and manholes (Contract) by executing the remaining three extension options, each for a one year period, in a cumulative amount not to exceed \$1,590,000, for a maximum total contract value not to exceed \$2,486,262.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend a total cumulative amount not to exceed \$1,590,000 from Sewer Operating Fund 700000 for the purpose of funding the three one-year extension options to the Contract, in the following averaged and approximated amounts for each of the three option years, with any unexpended funds available for expenditure in subsequent years:

- FY 2011: \$530,000, contingent upon the City Comptroller furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be on deposit with the City Treasurer.
- FY 2012: \$530,000, contingent upon the approval of the fiscal year 2012 Appropriation Ordinance and the City Comptroller furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be on deposit with the City Treasurer.

FY 2013: \$530,000, contingent upon the approval of the fiscal year 2013 Appropriation Ordinance and the City Comptroller furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be on deposit with the City Treasurer.
