A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING THE TERMINATION OF A WATER SHORTAGE EMERGENCY AND DROUGHT RESPONSE LEVELS.

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2011, Governor Jerry Brown declared California's three-year drought over since significant rainfall and snowpack has dramatically improved water supply conditions, and the State's reservoirs are all at above average levels; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2011, the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California Board of Directors voted to lift water allocations imposed by Drought Level 2; and

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2011, the San Diego County Water Authority Board voted to end water shortage allocations and lift the call for mandatory use restrictions; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is currently at Drought Level 2; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. That pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code Section 67.3809(d), the water shortage emergency and Drought Response Levels are hereby declared terminated.
