A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE ANNUAL PURCHASING CONTRACT AGREEMENT LIMIT TO PURCHASE FLEET MOTIVE EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, Contract No. C008100033 with Altec Industries Inc has been established via a competitive bidding process and approved by Purchasing and Contracting Department; and

WHEREAS, this action will authorize the Purchasing and Contracting Department to increase the \$1,000,000 annual purchase limitation to provide the replacement of twelve pieces of motive equipment for Street Division for the repair, maintenance and replacement of street lamps, traffic signals and park flood lighting systems and tree trimming throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the vehicles were included in the FY10 Fleet Services' Motive Equipment Acquisition Plan and funds are available in the Council approved General Service Department Fleet Replacement budget to lease purchase this motive equipment; and

WHEREAS, the vehicles will be funded by the City through a lease purchase agreement with JP Morgan Chase Bank, N.A. and approval of this agreement was adopted by the City Council on February 15, 2011 via Ordinance 20024; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Purchasing and Contracting Department is authorized to exceed the \$1,000,000 annual purchase limitation by an estimated \$799,060.00 on Contract No. C008100033 to acquire replacement trucks for overage Fleet Motive Equipment assigned to Street Division, Transportation and Storm Water Department.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
