A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER **MONTGOMERY FIELD AIRPORT** TRANSFER APPROPRIATION FUNDS, EXPENDING GRANT MATCHING FUNDS AND EXPEND FUNDS NECESSARY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MONTGOMERY FIELD RUNWAY 10L/28R REHABILITAITON PROJECT, APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE RUNWAY REHABILI-TATION PROJECT, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION HIS DESIGNEE. CONTRACT FOR THE RUNWAY REHABILITION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Montgomery Field Airport Runway 10L/28R was constructed in the 1950s and is in need of rehabilitation to enhance the safety of the runway and to conform to federal and state airport regulations and standards; and

WHEREAS, in July 2008, the City Council authorized the application for, and the acceptance of, a \$285,000 grant from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for the design of the Montgomery Field Runway 10L/28R Rehabilitation Project (Project), and also authorized the transfer and expenditure of \$170,000 from the Montgomery Field Annual Allocation for the design contract; and

WHEREAS, in July 2010, the City Council authorized the acceptance of a \$3,861,220 FAA grant to reimburse the Airports Division for costs associated with the Project; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of the Project is \$4,046,442; the \$3,861,220 FAA reimbursement grant funds represent 95% of the total estimated costs of the Project, and the

remaining 5% of the Project cost, \$203,222, is the responsibility of the Airports Division's Enterprise Fund; and

WHEREAS, actions sought by this resolution are: authorizations for the transfers and expenditures of funds for the Project; approval of the Plans and Specifications for the Project; and authorization to execute a construction contract, in an amount not to exceed \$4,064,442, with the lowest responsible and reliable bidder for the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to transfer appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$4,064,442 from CIP A-AA.00001, Montgomery Field Annual Allocation, of which \$3,861,220 is from Fund 710000, Federal Grant Fund, Grant No. 1000219-2010, and \$203,222 is from Fund 700030, Montgomery Field Special Aviation, to CIP S-00680, Montgomery Field Runway 10L/28R Rehabilitation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Plans and Specifications for the construction of CIP S-00680, Montgomery Field Runway 10L/28R Rehabilitation, as advertised by the Purchasing and Contracting Department, are approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute a construction contract with the lowest responsible and reliable bidder, in an amount not to exceed \$4,064,442, for the Montgomery Field Runway 10L/28R Rehabilitation Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend \$4,064,442 from CIP S-00680, Montgomery Field Runway 10L/28R Rehabilitation, \$203,222 of which is from Fund 700030, Montgomery Field Special Aviation, for the purpose of funding grant match requirements, and \$3,861,220 from Fund 710000, Federal Grant Fund, Grant No. 1000219-2010, for the purpose of construction of the Montgomery Field Runway 10L/28R

Rehabilitation Project, all contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer certifying that the funds are available.
