A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT BETWEEN
CHAD FARMER AND THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, Chad Farmer filed a claim with the City of San Diego (City) for damage to his property caused by a water main break on October 7, 2010. The water main break caused flooding damage to his property, City of San Diego Risk Management Department Claim number 3196; and

WHEREAS, in Closed Session on May 10, 2011, the City Council, by the following votes: Yeas, District(s) 1, 2, 4, 6, 7, and 8; absent, District(s) 3 and 5, approved settlement of the claim for an amount consistent with the amounts set forth below; NOW, THEREFORE,

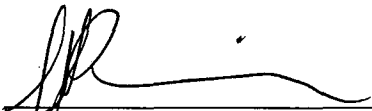
BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Council authorizes:

1. Authorizing the sum of \$108,125 to be paid in settlement of each and every claim for damages, interests, costs and fees of any type, including but not limited to attorneys fees, against the City of San Diego, its agents and employees arising from the claim of Chad Farmer against the City of San Diego.

2. Authorizing the Chief Financial Officer to expend the amount of \$108,125 from the Water Utility Operating Fund, 700011, contingent upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2012 Annual Budget, Annual Appropriation Ordinance and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

3. Authorizing the Comptroller to issue a check in the amount of \$108,125 made payable to Chad Farmer.

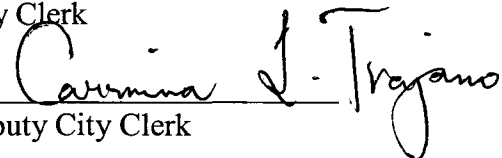
