A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING AN EXTENSION OF THE AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND GENEX/INTRACORP SERVICES INC. TO PROVIDE WORKERS' COMPENSATION MANAGED CARE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego self-insures and self-administers its Workers' Compensation Insurance Program in accordance with the California Labor Code; and

WHEREAS, the self-administration of the City's Workers' Compensation Program is the responsibility of the Risk Management Department, which provides Workers' Compensation benefits to all eligible City employees and establishes programs, allowed by the Labor Code, that provide appropriate medical care; and

WHEREAS, in 2008, the City awarded contracts for integrated Managed Care services to Intracorp and other vendors; and

WHEREAS, the integrated Managed Care contracts provide the following services to the City's Workers' Compensation Program: Medical Bill Review, Medical Utilization Review, Preferred Provider Organization (PPO), Medical Case Management and Injury Call Center services; and

WHEREAS, extensions of the contracts with Genex/Intracorp Services Inc. and the other vendors to continue providing integrated Managed Care services are needed; and

WHEREAS, the estimated two-year contract cost to the City is \$2.2 million, of which \$1.1 million is for Fiscal Year 2012 and \$1.1 million is for Fiscal Year 2013; and

WHEREAS, funding for the contract is available from Workers' Compensation Fund 720044; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. Authorize the Mayor to execute an extension of the Agreement with Genex/Intracorp Services Inc. to provide the City with Workers' Compensation Medical Bill Review, Utilization Review, Preferred Provider Organization Use and Injury Call-In Center services for a period of two years.
- 2. Authorize the Mayor to execute an extension of the Agreements with Genex/Intracorp, EK Health, Monitor, and Corvel to provide the City with Workers' Compensation Field Nurse Case Management for a period of two years.
- 3. Authorize the Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and expend in Fiscal Year 2012 the amount of \$1.1 million from the Workers' Compensation Fund 720044, provided that the Chief Financial Officer first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

4. Authorize the Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and expend in Fiscal Year 2013 the amount of \$1.1 million from the Workers' Compensation Fund 720044, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
