

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 307008

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE SEP 28 2011

WHEREAS, the Independent Rates Oversight Committee (IROC) is established in the San Diego Municipal Code (Municipal Code) under Chapter 2, Article 6, Division 20, to advise the Mayor and City Council on policy issues relating to the oversight of the City of San Diego's public utilities department operations; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the IROC shall consist of eleven members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the members shall serve staggered four-year terms; each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed; and all terms must have an expiration date of May 1;

WHEREAS, members shall include at least one member from each of the following four ratepayer classes: single family residential, multifamily residential, commercial and industrial, and temporary irrigation and construction; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the members shall possess expertise in one or more of the following areas: accounting, auditing, engineering, biology or environmental science, finance or municipal finance, law, and construction management; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following appointment by the Mayor of the City of San Diego to serve as a member of the Independent Rates Oversight Committee, for the term ending as indicated, is made and hereby confirmed:
