A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ENDORSING THE KEYS TO HOUSING TOOLBOX DEVELOPED BY THE SAN DIEGO GRANTMAKERS HOMELESSNESS WORKING GROUP.

WHEREAS, approximately 13,200 homeless children in the San Diego region were served by public school homeless liaisons in 2010, according to the San Diego County Office of Education; and

WHEREAS, each night nearly 1,700 children in the region live on the streets, in shelters, or in cars or other places not meant for human habitation, according to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, City of San Diego and County of San Diego Point In Time Summary; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Grantmakers Homelessness Working Group believes that affordable housing, education, and employment positively impact the ability of families to maintain stable homes and productive participation in the community; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Grantmakers Homelessness Working Group believes that housing, education, and employment can be keys in the prevention of and recovery from homelessness; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Grantmakers Homelessness Working Group believes that stable housing can be a platform for improved outcomes in education and health; and

WHEREAS, according to the Regional Taskforce on the Homeless, homeless prevention and rapid re-housing services have proven to be effective in preventing and ending homelessness for nearly 2,000 households in our local communities; and

WHEREAS, according to the San Diego Grantmakers Homelessness Working Group,

growing local and regional support has been offered from a broad cross section of community

stakeholders during the development of the Keys to Housing Toolbox; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Grantmakers Homelessness Working Group believes that

advocacy and action are essential to achieving the goal of ending family homelessness in our

region; and

WHEREAS, according to the San Diego Grantmakers Homelessness Working Group, the

United States Interagency Council on the Homeless has established a goal of ending family

homelessness by 2020; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Council

endorses the Keys to Housing Toolbox developed by the San Diego Grantmakers Homelessness

Working Group and will join with other jurisdictions and organizations to take action and

measure progress in achieving the goal of ending family homelessness by 2020.
