A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH LUTH & TURLEY FOR ASNEEDED REMEDIATION AND CLEANUP SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of issuing a Request for Proposals to provide remediation and cleanup services to respond to water main breaks and sewer backups in the City's utility systems; and

WHEREAS, the funds remaining in the current contract with Luth & Turley may not be sufficient to respond to all water main breaks and sewer backups while the Request for Proposals is pending; and

WHEREAS, if the City does not have a firm on call to respond to water main breaks and sewer backups, some property owners may not have the financial ability to clean up their properties themselves, thereby endangering their health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the City needs to extend the current contract with Luth & Turley and authorize additional funding while a new contract advertised and awarded; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of the City, an amendment to the contract with Luth & Turley, Inc. to provide asneeded remediation and cleanup services, under the terms and conditions set forth in the First Amendment, on file with the City Clerk as Document No. RR-_____3071272

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an additional amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 in Fiscal Year 2012, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the above referenced contract as amended, to be expended as follows: \$800,000 from Water Fund No. 700011 and \$200,000 from Municipal Sewer Fund No. 700000; provided that the final allocation of the \$1,000,000 between the Water and Sewer Funds be adjusted to reflect the actual proportionate share of damages caused by water main breaks and sewer backups, respectively.
