AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE APPLICATION THE GRANT APPLICATION SUBMITTAL AND RELATED ACTIONS FOR THE NORMAL STREET LINEAR PARK.

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2006, California voters passed Proposition 84, the Safe Driving Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Projection Bond Act of 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Statewide Park Program, which is funded by Proposition 84, will award grants on a competitive basis for the creation of new parks and recreation opportunities in proximity to the most critically underserved communities across California; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility by the Legislature of the State of California for the administration of the Statewide Park Program and has instituted procedures governing the application for grants under the Program; and

WHEREAS, the procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require applicants to certify by resolution the approval of applications to the State; and

WHEREAS, the Normal Street Linear Park Project (Project) fully meets the intent of the Statewide Park Program to finance the development of parks, recreation areas, and facilities in neighborhoods currently least served by park and recreation providers; and

WHEREAS, the Uptown community is deficient in park facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on February 2, 1988, pursuant to Resolution No. R-270273, adopted the Uptown Community Plan, which recommends developing the excess Normal Street right-of-way as a linear park; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2011, the City of San Diego submitted an application for \$4,791,000 in Statewide Park Program Funds for the Normal Street Linear Park; and

WHEREAS, if awarded grant funds by the State, the City will enter into a contract with the State of California to complete the grant scope;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- Section 1. That the Mayor or his representative is authorized to make an application to the State of California for an amount not to exceed \$4,791,000 in Statewide Park

  Development and Community Revitalization Program of 2008 grant funds for the completion of the Normal Street Linear Park.
- Section 2. That the Mayor or his representative is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure funding from the State of California for the completion of the Normal Street Linear Park.
- Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate, accept and expend funds, if grant funding is secured.
- Section 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest bearing account for the grant funds.
- Section 5. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to add CIP No. S-12032, Normal Street Linear Park, to the Capital Improvements Program.

- Section 6. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Fiscal Year 2012 CIP Budget in an amount not to exceed \$4,791,000 in CIP No. S-12032 for the design and construction of the Normal Street Linear Park, upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
- Section 7. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$4,791,000 from CIP No. S-12032 for the design and construction of the Normal Street Linear Park, upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
- Section 8. That the City certifies that it will have sufficient funds available to complete the project, prior to commencement of any work on the Project included in the application, should the grant be awarded.
- Section 9. That the City certifies it will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the Project.
- Section 10. That the City certifies it has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the contract shown in the Grant Administration Guide.
- Section 11. That the Mayor or his delegated representative is authorized to conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the Project.
- Section 12. That the City agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, and guidelines in the execution of the grant agreement.
- Section 13. That the City certifies the Project is consistent with the City of San Diego General Plan and all other applicable planning documents.
- Section 14. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 15. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
