DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE OCT 02 2012

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH ROSELING NAKAMURA TERADA ARCHITECTS, INC. FOR THE LA JOLLA COVE LIFEGUARD STATION.

WHEREAS, the La Jolla Cove Lifeguard Station is located at 1160 Coast Boulevard in La Jolla; and

WHEREAS, the existing facility is old, undersized, deteriorated and no longer serves the needs of the lifeguard staff nor the beach going public; and

WHEREAS, project scope includes design and construction of a new facility with an observation tower, first aid room, male/female locker rooms, second observation area, an accessible ramp to the mid landing, and a public view area; and

WHEREAS, Roseling Nakamura Terada Architects, Inc. was selected in accordance with Council Policy 300-7, and entered into an agreement with the City of San Diego on October 14, 2002 as Document No. C-11638; and

WHEREAS, the proposed second amendment to the agreement with Roseling Nakamura Terada Architects, Inc. is required to provide support during construction and to provide as-built drawings; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute, on behalf of said City, the second amendment to an agreement with Roseling Nakamura Terada Architects, Inc. for the purpose of completing the design of the La Jolla Cove Lifeguard Station under the terms and conditions set forth in the Amendment on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO 20193, together with any reasonably necessary modifications or amendments thereto which do not increase project scope or cost and which the Mayor shall deem necessary from time to time in order to carry out the purposes and intent of this project and agreement.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$25,000 from WBS No.S-00792, La Jolla Cove Lifeguard Station, Fund 400123, La Jolla Urban, for the purpose of providing funds for the above-referenced amendment.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.


