AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A SEWER SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE RANCHO SANTA FE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, several parcels within the County of San Diego, east of the City of Solana Beach, are currently using septic tanks for disposal of household sewage; and

WHEREAS, the area is subject to flooding, making continued use of septic tanks impractical; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego currently provides sewer services to areas outside the City limits and adjacent to these parcels; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) has approved having the Rancho Santa Fe Community Services District (RSFCSD) provide sewer service to the parcels with the expectation that RSFCSD will transport the sewage to the City of San Diego for treatment and disposal; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, an agreement with the Rancho Santa Fe Community Services District, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Sewer Service Agreement, on file with the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 20215.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
