WHEREAS, in Closed Session on November 1, 2011, the City Council, by the following votes: Yeas, District(s) 1, 2, 5, 6, 7, Nays, District(s) None; and absent, District(s) 3, 4, 8, authorized settlement of the Litigation for an amount consistent with the amounts set forth below and pursuant to such other terms more fully set forth below; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Council authorizes:

- 1. The sum of \$70,950 to be paid from the Public Liability Fund No. 720045, in settlement of each and every claim for damages, interest, costs and fees of any type, including attorney fees, against the City, its agents and employees, arising from the personal injury claim of Robert Koll, San Diego Superior Court Case No. 37-2010-00104315-CU-CR-CTL.
- 2. The Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and expend \$70,950 from the Public Liability Fund 720045, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
