A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA STRATEGIC GROWTH COUNCIL FOR SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES PLANNING GRANT FOR THE PREPARATION OF A SUSTAINABLE PARKS STRATEGIC PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84) authorized \$60 million (in three cycles) for Sustainable Communities Plans; and

WHEREAS, during the first cycle, the City of San Diego was awarded a one million dollar grant to update the Southeastern San Diego Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, for the second cycle, the City now seeks the maximum grant amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to create a citywide Sustainable Parks Strategic Plan; and

WHEREAS, Sustainable Communities Planning Grant funds are designed to help local governments develop plans and integrated strategies that transform communities to accomplish goals such as improving infrastructure, revitalizing urban and community centers, improving air and water quality and public health, reducing automobile usage, strengthening the economy, and promoting water conservation and energy efficiency; and

WHEREAS, a citywide Sustainable Parks Strategic Plan would help implement the City's General Plan policy recommendation to prepare a Parks Master Plan, with the added benefit of focusing on meeting existing and future needs and challenges through sustainable strategies and solutions; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. The Mayor or his representative is authorized to make an application to the

California Strategic Growth Council and to take all necessary actions to secure funding for an

amount up to one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in Sustainable Communities Planning Grant funds

for the preparation of a citywide Sustainable Parks Strategic Plan.

2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept up to one million dollars

(\$1,000,000) if the grant funding is secured.

The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing 3.

account, if required.

4. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend up to one

million dollars (\$1,000,000) in Sustainable Communities Planning Grant funds for the purpose of

preparing a citywide Sustainable Parks Strategic Plan, contingent upon receipt of a fully

executed grant agreement.
