WHEREAS, NovaComm dba EvoNexus has requested funding for its pro bono

Downtown High-Tech Incubator program to stimulate the establishment and growth of high-tech start-ups, resulting in job creation in the San Diego region; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06, Community Projects, Programs and Services; and

WHEREAS, Council District Three recommends an allocation of \$10,000 to NovaComm dba EvoNexus, for the purposes set forth herein; NOW, THEREFORE,

described herein is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to

negotiate and execute for and on behalf of the City, an Agreement with NovaComm dba

EvoNexus in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 for operation of the Downtown High-Tech

Incubator.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend

an amount not to exceed \$10,000 from the Community Projects, Programs and Services budget,

Fund No. 100000, Cost Center 1103110003, to provide funds for the above-referenced

agreement, contingent upon the City Comptroller first furnishing one or more certificates

certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City

Treasurer.
