A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION TO THE CONTRACT WITH MISSION GEOGRAPHIC FOR THE CITYWIDE PAVEMENT ASSESSMENT SURVEY; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS RELATED TO THE SURVEY.

WHEREAS, in January 2011 by Resolution No. R-306521, the Council authorized a one-year contract for an assessment of the City's pavement, which included options to renew the contract for up to four additional one-year periods; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to exercise the option to renew the contract for one additional year to provide for continuing services; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a renewal option to the contract with Mission Geographic, LLC, to provide consultant services related to the Citywide Pavement Assessment Survey, for a term of one year, under the terms and conditions set forth in Bid No. 10007110-11-P, on file with the City Clerk as Document Number RR- 306521.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer, or designee, is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$59,900 from Fund Center 2116110013, Street Division, Fund No. 100000, General Fund of the Transportation & Stormwater Department, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the above option to renew the contract with Mission Geographic, LLC, provided that the Chief


Financial Officer furnishes a certificate demonstrating that the funds for this expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.
