WHEREAS, testing at Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant Power Center 6 (Power Center 6) revealed serious safety and operational problems that necessitated an immediate response; and

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Department determined the situation at Power Center 6 was an emergency and requested Ahrens Corporation (Ahrens) to perform the necessary work under the City's On-Call Emergency Contract; and

WHEREAS, section 22.3212(c) of the San Diego Municipal Code requires that the City Council of the City of San Diego (Council) ratify contracts awarded in response to an emergency and without competitive bidding; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council, that the contract awarded to Ahrens for design-build construction services in response to the emergency situation at Power Center 6 in the amount of \$183,207, a copy of which contract is on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 307301, is hereby ratified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$183,207 from CIP ABO00001 Annual Allocation – Metro Treatment Plants (B-10225), Fund 700001, Sewer, for the purpose of the aforementioned

Contract, provided that the Chief Financial Officer first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasury.
