A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH
THE CASCADIA CONSULTING GROUP, INC., FOR
WASTE CHARACTERIZATION SERVICES AND
AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS.

WHEREAS, in May 2011, the City issued Request for Proposal No. 10015022-11-W to provide a comprehensive survey of the waste delivered to the Miramar Landfill, which the City will use to improve recycling and diversion programs; and

WHEREAS, Cascadia Consulting Group, Inc., was selected to provide the services, subject to City Council approval; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a three-year agreement with Cascadia Consulting Group, Inc., for waste characterization services (“Agreement”), including an option to renew the Agreement for up to one additional year, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR - 307314

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$339,000 from Refuse Disposal Fund No. 700039, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the above Agreement, contingent on passage of the Annual Appropriations Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year and provided that the City Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds for this expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.
