A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT BETWEEN RAPHEAL WATKINS AND THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO

WHEREAS, in Closed Session on January 31, 2012, the City Council voted 7 to 1 (District 5 voting against) to approve the settlement of Rapheal Watkins' disability discrimination lawsuit against the City of San Diego, San Diego Superior Court Case No 37-2010-00106192-CU-WT-CTL.


BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to pay the sum of \$180,000.00 from Public Liability Fund No. 720045 in settlement of each and every claim for damages, interest, costs and fees of any type, including but not limited to attorney's fees, against the City of San Diego, its agents and employees, resulting from the claim of Rapheal Watkins, San Diego Superior Court Case No. 37-2010-00106192-CU-WT-CTL.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to appropriate and expend \$180,000.00 from Public Liability Fund No. 720045, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Comptroller is hereby authorized to issue a check in the amount of \$180,000.00 made payable to the Walters & Caietti, APC Client Trust

Account, in full and final settlement of all of Rapheal Watkins' claims against the City of San Diego, its agents and employees.
