BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Comptroller is hereby authorized to issue a check in the amount of \$180,000.00 made payable to the Walters & Caietti, APC Client Trust

Account, in full and final settlement of all of Rapheal Watkins' claims against the City of San Diego, its agents and employees.
