BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend funds in an amount not to exceed \$6,629,000 from Fund 700008, Sewer, CIP No. A-JA.00002, Pipeline Rehabilitation (B-11078, Pipeline Rehabilitation S-1), for the purpose of funding the construction contract and related project costs, contingent upon approval of the FY2013 and FY2014 Appropriation Ordinances, and provided that the Chief Financial Officer furnishes one

or more certificates demonstrating that funds necessary for expenditure under the established contract funding phases are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasury.
