A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MOODY INTERNATIONAL TO PERFORM AN ACCOUNTS PAYABLE RECOVERY AUDIT OF THE CITY AND RELATED SERVICES.

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2011, the Audit Committee requested that the Independent Budget Analyst prepare a request for proposals (RFP) to identify a vendor or vendors to conduct an audit of the City's accounts payable; and

WHEREAS, on November 22, 2011, the RFP was released and the City received two proposals prior to the RFP's closing date of December 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, based on the proposals received, the Evaluation Committee recommended that the Moody International (the Firm) be retained to conduct the accounts payable audit; and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2012, the Audit Committee considered the recommendation of the Evaluation Committee and forwarded such recommendation to the City Council for approval; and

WHEREAS, the Firm has agreed to conduct the audit in exchange for 19% of any confirmed recovery for the City with a compensation cap of \$100,000 for any single recovery; and

WHEREAS, because the Firm's compensation is contingent on the successful recovery of City revenue, there is no net cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Comptroller will oversee the Agreement and the work of the Firm; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to enter into an agreement (Agreement) with the Firm to provide an accounts payable recovery audit and recovery services in accordance with the RFP and the Firm's response thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Agreement shall be for a term of five years or less.
