A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FUNDING TO NATIONAL VETERANS TRANSITION SERVICES, INC., SAN DIEGO NATURAL HISTORY MUSEUM, SAN DIEGO MUSEUM OF ART, BENBOUGH OPERATING FOUNDATION, HOUSE OF PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS, AND NORTH PARK ORGANIZATION OF BUSINESS, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, entitled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by Resolution R-306903; and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the following organizations have requested funding for the following purposes:

National Veterans Transition Services, Inc.	REBOOT workshop programming	Reduces veteran unemployment and homelessness; improves economic productivity
San Diego Natural History Museum	Canyoneers Guided Hikes and Paleontology Fossil Recovery	Enhances the importance of sustainability and recreation in the City of San Diego
San Diego Museum of Art	Energy Efficient LED Lighting	Helps to save energy and improve quality of lighting
Benbough Operating Foundation	Wounded Warrior Training Program	Reduces unemployment rates among wounded military members; benefits local safety net providers and community-at-large
House of Pacific Relations International Cottages, Inc.	Saturday at the Lawn Programming	Provides free musical and dance entertainment to create a greater sense of community

North Park Organization of Business, Inc.	I-805 Gateway Beautification Project and Going Green Bike Corrals	These projects will create a greater sense of community and pride, and create sustainable practices throughout the community

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described programs fit within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06, Community Projects, Programs and Services; and

WHEREAS, Council District Three recommends the following allocations for the purposes set forth herein:

National Veterans Transition Services, Inc.	\$5,000
San Diego Natural History Museum	\$8,056
San Diego Museum of Art	\$10,000
Benbough Operating Foundation	\$10,000
House of Pacific Relations International Cottages, Inc.	\$1,500
North Park Organization of Business, Inc.	\$4,000

; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocations described herein are made for a public purpose.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby waives Council Policy 100-06, 3(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to negotiate and execute for and on behalf of the City, Agreements with (1) National Veterans Transition Services, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$5,000; (2) San Diego Natural History

Museum in an amount not to exceed \$8,056; (3) San Diego Museum of Art in an amount not to exceed \$10,000; (4) Benbough Operating Foundation in an amount not to exceed \$10,000; (5) House of Pacific Relations International Cottages, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$1,500; and (6) North Park Organization of Business, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$4,000 for the projects described herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend the amounts described herein from the Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center 1103110003, to provide funds for the above-referenced agreements, contingent upon the City Comptroller first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.


