WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) owns a facility located at 8450 Mira Mesa Boulevard, San Diego, California (City Property); and

(Harmonium), has been operating a self-supporting teen business center (the Center) on a portion of the City Property; the Center provides educational activities, community services, recreational programs, counseling services, and operates an entrepreneurial business center for teens; and

WHEREAS, in order to qualify for Community Development Block Grant funds for roof, sewer and drainage repairs for the City Property, Harmonium requires a minimum lease term of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, City staff has negotiated a proposed five (5) year lease with Harmonium which would lease an approximate 6,438 square feet of the City Property to Harmonium for the Center; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into and execute a five (5) year lease with Harmonium, Inc., for the purposes of operating its self-supporting teen business center, and subject to the terms and conditions contained therein, which are more fully set forth in Document No. _RR 307489 __ on file with the City Clerk.
