WHEREAS, in 2009, the Office of the City Attorney was awarded a grant from the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board (State Agency), in an amount not to exceed \$75,194, to fund the Criminal Restitution Compact Restitution Specialist position in the Office of the City Attorney, Criminal Division, for a one-year period from July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010, pursuant to Resolution R-305005; and

WHEREAS, in 2010, the Office of the City Attorney and the State Agency amended the agreement, in an amount not to exceed \$78,000, to allow for continued performance of the agreement for an additional one-year period, from July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, pursuant to Resolution R-306053; and

WHEREAS, in 2011, the State Agency awarded the City a new grant in the amount of \$75,463.14, to continue to fund the Criminal Restitution Compact Restitution Specialist position for a one-year period, from July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012, and such agreement was approved pursuant to Resolution R-306991; and

WHEREAS, the State Agency has notified the Office of the City Attorney of an award of a new grant in an amount of \$75,463.14, to continue to fund the Criminal Restitution Compact Restitution Specialist position for a one-year period, from July 1, 2012, through June 30, 2013; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Office of the City Attorney is hereby authorized to apply for and take all necessary actions to secure funding of a grant in an amount not to exceed \$75,463.14 from the State Victim Compensation and

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Government Claims Board to fund the Criminal Restitution Compact Restitution Specialist position in the Office of the City Attorney, Criminal Division, for a one-year period, from July 1, 2012, through June 30, 2013, on the terms and conditions outlined in Standard Agreement Number VCGC2077, a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk's Office as Document No. 307493

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Office of the City Attorney is authorized to submit all documents, negotiate and execute all agreements necessary, including any amendments, to comply with the grant requirements, and carry out and administer all obligations, responsibilities and duties under the grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend up to \$75,463.14 in grant funds from the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board, for the purpose of funding the Criminal Restitution Compact Restitution Specialist position in the Office of the City Attorney, Criminal Division, for a one-year period, from July 1, 2012, through June 30, 2013, contingent upon a fully executed grant agreement, and provided that the Chief Financial Officer first furnish one or more certificates certifying that the funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grant money.
