A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FUNDING TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH COALITION, SAN DIEGO POLICE FOUNDATION, CASA FAMILIAR, BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT COUNCIL, THE GREATER WORKS EMPOWERMENT CENTER, AND THE SHERMAN HEIGHTS COMMUNITY CENTER, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, entitled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903; and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the following organizations have requested funding for the following purposes:

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described programs fit within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06, Community Projects, Programs and Services; and

WHEREAS, Council District Eight recommends the following allocations for the purposes set forth herein:

Environmental Health Coalition	\$2,210
San Diego Police Foundation	\$1,000
Casa Familiar	\$14,700
Business Improvement District Council	\$1,125
The Greater Works Empowerment Center	\$3,400
Sherman Heights Community Center	\$14,700

WHEREAS, \$1,200 of the \$14,700 allocation to the Sherman Heights Community Center Corporation is intended to increase the \$1,200 amount that Council District Eight allocated at the City Council meeting of May 22, 2012 for a total amount of \$2,400 to the Sherman Heights Community Center for a computer, screen and projector; the remaining \$13,500 allocated to Sherman Heights Community Center will be used for the purposes set forth herein; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocations described herein are made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby waives Council Policy 100-06, 3(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to negotiate and execute for and on behalf of the City, Agreements with (1) Environmental Health Coalition in an amount not to exceed \$2,210; (2) San Diego Police Foundation in an amount not to exceed \$1,000; (3) Casa Familiar in an amount not to exceed \$14,700; (4) Business Improvement District Council in an amount not to exceed \$1,125; (5) The Greater Works Empowerment Center in an amount not to exceed \$3,400; and (6) Sherman Heights Community Center in an amount not to exceed \$14,700 for the projects described herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend the amounts described herein from the Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center 1108110008, to provide funds for the above-referenced agreements, contingent upon the City Comptroller first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.


