A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PURSUANT TO SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE COMM 22 FAMILY HOUSING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (Authority) intends to issue not to exceed \$30,000,000 aggregate principal amount of multifamily housing revenue bonds (Bonds) to finance the acquisition, construction and equipping of a multifamily rental housing project in the City of San Diego described in the notice of public hearing attached as Exhibit A hereto (Project); and

WHEREAS, in order for interest on the Bonds to be tax-exempt, Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 requires that the Bonds be approved by the City Council as the applicable elected representative after a public hearing following reasonable public notice; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing with respect to the proposed issuance of the Bonds was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City on June 22 2012; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held on July <u>10</u>, 2012, and an opportunity was provided for interested persons to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds and on the nature and location of the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego that this City Council, as the applicable elected representative under Section 147(f) of the Code, approves the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City does not warrant the creditworthiness of the Bonds or guarantee, in any way, the payment of the Bonds. No moneys of the City will be pledged or applied to the repayment of the Bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to the State of California Environmental Quality Act, the City of San Diego previously evaluated the environmental impacts associated with this project in the City Council's December 4, 2007 approval of a Certification of Mitigated Negative Declaration No. 122002 pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act.

Processing under the National Environmental Policy Act is not required as no federal funds are involved in this action.
