A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR A CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY DUI ENFORCEMENT AND AWARENESS PROGRAM GRANT FOR THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1, 2011, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2012.

WHEREAS, the California Office of Traffic Safety DUI Enforcement and Awareness Program has initiated a grant for the period October 1, 2011, through September 30, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the object of the program will be to reduce the number of persons killed and injured in alcohol-related crashes; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) will employ various best-practice strategies including checkpoints, saturation patrols, stakeouts, and sting operations; and

WHEREAS, in order to reduce the persons killed and injured in alcohol-involved crashes, best-practice strategies will be conducted on an overtime basis. The funded strategies include DUI/Driver's License checkpoints and DUI saturation patrols. This program will also develop a "Hot Sheet" program and conduct stakeout operations for officers to concentrate on repeat offenders on probation who have had their license suspended or revoked. Sting operations will focus on DUI offenders with a suspended or revoked driver license who get behind the wheel after leaving court. Through warrant service details, SDPD will target repeat DUI violators who failed to appear in court or who violate probation. These strategies are designed to earn media attention thus enhancing the overall deterrent effect; and

WHEREAS, all expenses resulting from this action are grant funded; there is no requirement for continued expenditures or services once grant funding is depleted or terminated; and

WHEREAS, this program is subject to the City's Equal Opportunity Contracting (San Diego Ordinance No. 18173), sections 22.2701 through 22.2708 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and Non-Discrimination in Contracting Ordinance (San Diego Municipal Code sections 22.3501 through 22.3517); NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his representative is authorized, for and behalf of the City, to apply for, accept, appropriate, and expend \$427,000, or the actual amount of funding authorized by the California Office of Traffic Safety, including any amendments, extensions, renewals, or subsequent funding for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the Office of Traffic Safety, for the purpose of implementing the DUI Enforcement and Awareness Program for Fiscal Year 2012, Fund 600001/1000038-2012.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grants, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept up to \$427,000 or the actual amount of funding authorized by the California Office of Traffic Safety if the grant funding is secured.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend \$427,000, or the actual amount of funding authorized by the California Office of Traffic Safety, including any amendments, extensions, renewals, or subsequent funding

for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the California Office of Traffic Safety, for the purpose of implementing the DUI Enforcement and Awareness Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police is authorized to administer and operate this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his representative, including the Chief of Police, is authorized to certify that the City of San Diego will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to this grant program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of San Diego is authorized to apply, accept, appropriate, and expend funds for any amendments, extensions, renewals, or subsequent funding for this grant program for the period Fiscal Year 2012 through Fiscal Year 2016.
