A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE UPDATED ENGINEERS REPORTS FOR THE SELF-MANAGED MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS, AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUED LEVY AND COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013 WITHIN THE SELF-MANAGED MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS, AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS.

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2012, pursuant to Resolution No. R-307586, the City Council preliminarily approved the updates to the Engineer's Reports for the following self-managed Maintenance Assessment Districts (MADs), which are on file with the Office of the City Clerk as follows:

WHEREAS, after holding a public hearing and considering all protests, no majority protest exists with respect to any of the above self-managed MADs; and

WHEREAS, there are no proposed increases to the assessments, other than those authorized at the time of formation, including increases based on the San Diego Consumer Price Index; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that:

- 1. That the updated Fiscal Year 2013 Engineer's Reports for each of the City's self-managed Maintenance Assessment Districts (MADs) is hereby approved as filed.
- 2. The continued levy and collection of assessments on parcels within the above self-managed MADs is hereby authorized for Fiscal Year 2013 to pay a prescribed portion of the costs of improvements and/or services as described in each Engineer's Report.
- 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend the MAD funds, including the administrative fund, district operating funds, district capital funds, and developer deposit funds associated with new assessment district formation activities for Fiscal Year 2013 contingent upon approval of the Fiscal Year 2013 Appropriation Ordinance and contingent upon the City Comptroller certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are or will be available.
- 4. Authorize the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Fiscal Year 2013 Budget as follows:
 - a. Increase the C&ED Admin MAD Fund (200086) expenditure appropriations by \$50,000
 - b. Increase the Newport Avenue MAD Fund (200061) expenditure appropriations by \$14,566
 - c. Increase the Central Commercial MAD Fund (200078) revenue budget by \$3,310
 - d. Increase the College Heights MAD Fund (200084) revenue budget by \$7,739
 - e. Increase the Newport Avenue MAD Fund (200055) revenue budget by \$1,187
 - f. Decrease the Adams Avenue MAD Fund (200055) expenditure appropriations by \$3
 - g. Decrease the Central Commercial MAD Fund (200078) expenditure appropriations by \$61,330
 - h. Decrease the City Heights MAD Fund (200087) expenditure appropriations by \$3,040

- i. Decrease the College Heights MAD Fund (200084) expenditure appropriations by \$122,261
- j. Decrease the Hillcrest Commercial Core MAD Fund (200105) expenditure appropriations by \$12,999
- k. Decrease the Little Italy MAD Fund (200079) expenditure appropriations by \$105,047
