A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A LANDSCAPE CONTRACT  
WITH LANDSCAPES USA FOR THE SCRIPPS-MIRAMAR  
RANCH MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the landscape activities and areas of maintenance in the Scripps-Miramar Ranch Maintenance Assessment District (Scripps-Miramar Ranch MAD) include care and cleaning of street medians, parkway landscapes, sidewalks, curbs, gutters, landscaped slopes, mini-parks, greenbelts, and open space areas; and

WHEREAS, regular maintenance tasks include litter removal, sweeping, edging, trimming, weeding, and related functions; and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Mayor or his designee is authorized to award and execute, for and on behalf of the City, a phase-funded contract with Landscapes USA for landscape maintenance services within the Scripps-Miramar Ranch MAD, having an initial term of one year.


2. The Mayor or his designee is authorized to exercise up to four one-year contract extension options with Landscapes USA, contingent upon adoption of the resolution authorizing the levy of assessments within the Scripps-Miramar Ranch MAD and the Annual Budget Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and provided that the Chief Financial Officer first furnishes one or more certificates that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.

3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$2,466,617 over five years (\$125,745 in Fiscal Year 2012; \$452,683 in Fiscal Year 2013; \$475,317 in Fiscal Year 2014; \$499,083 in Fiscal Year 2015; \$524,037 in Fiscal Year 2016; and

\$389,752 in Fiscal Year 2017) from Fund No. 200028, Scripps-Miramar Ranch Maintenance Assessment District, for the purpose of funding the above contract, contingent upon adoption of the resolution authorizing the levy of assessments within the Scripps-Miramar Ranch MAD and the Annual Budget Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and provided that the Chief Financial Officer first furnishes one or more certificates that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.
