BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$100,000,000 to fund task orders to be issued under the above multiple award design-build contracts, provided that no task order may exceed \$10,000,000 without City Council approval, that each project was previously identified and appropriated through the approved Annual Capital Improvements Program budget, and that the Chief Financial Officer first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
