A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO RENEW
THE CITY'S CONTRACTS FOR PERIODICAL
SUBSCRIPTION SERVICES FOR PERIODICALS FOR THE
SAN DIEGO PUBLIC LIBRARY

WHEREAS, after a competitive bid process, the City of San Diego entered into a contract with EBSCO Subscription Service to provide subscriptions to periodicals listed on the City's Main Title List (the Subscription Contract); and

WHEREAS, the Subscription Contract is for a period of two years beginning September 1, 2009, with three one-year options to renew; and

WHEREAS, the City exercised the first option to renew, by resolution of the City Council (R-307123) adopted on November 30, 2011, for the new contract year from September 1, 2011 through August 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, EBSCO has indicated its willingness to renew the Subscription Contract on the same terms and conditions as are currently contained in the contract; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Subscription Contract, subscription services are provided to the San Diego Public Library as requested by the City; and

WHEREAS, for the first three years of the Subscription Contract, the City spent \$1,025,428 for subscription services; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to exercise the option to renew for the second and third option years from September 1, 2012 through August 31, 2014, and expects to spend \$692,000

for subscription services during the remaining two option years, for a total contract amount of \$1,717,428; and

WHEREAS, renewal of the third option year is contingent upon certification by the Comptroller that funds are available; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a renewal of the City's contract for periodical subscription services with EBSCO Subscription Service for a period of one year beginning September 1, 2012 through August 31, 2013 (the fourth year of the contract) on the terms and conditions set forth in Contract No. 4600000023 dated August 26, 2009 (Bid No. 9500-09-L), to provide subscriptions to periodicals listed on the City's Main Title List as requested by the City up to \$346,000; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a renewal of the City's contract for periodical subscription services with EBSCO Subscription Service for a period of one year beginning September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014 (the fifth and final year of the contract) on the terms and conditions set forth in Contract No. 4600000023 dated August 26, 2009 (Bid No. 9500-09-L), to provide subscriptions to periodicals listed on the City's Main Title List as requested by City up to \$346,000, contingent upon certification by the Comptroller that funds have been appropriated and are available for this purpose; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to expend: (1) up to \$346,000 from fund number 100000 for periodical subscription services pursuant to the contract with EBSCO Subscription Service for the contract year beginning September 1, 2012; and (2) contingent upon certification by the Comptroller that funds have been

appropriated and are available for this purpose, up to \$346,000 from fund number 100000 for periodical subscription services pursuant to the contract with EBSCO Subscription Service for the contract year beginning September 1, 2013, for a total contract amount for services through August 31, 2014 not to exceed \$1,717,428.
