A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS
DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND
EXPEND UP TO \$379,856 IN FY 2012 STATE HOMELAND
SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING

WHEREAS, the State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSP) is a component of the
Federal Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) 2012 Homeland Security Grant Program;
and

WHEREAS, activities implemented under the SHSP must support terrorism preparedness
by building or enhancing capabilities that relate to the prevention of, protection from, response
to, or recovery from terrorism in order to be considered eligible; and

WHEREAS, the SHSP funded activities must also align with national, state, and urban
area strategic objectives; and

WHEREAS, many capabilities that support terrorism preparedness simultaneously
support preparedness for other hazards and catastrophic incidents; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) will directly receive \$379,856 awarded through
the County of San Diego under the FY 2012 SHSP; and

WHEREAS, the funding allocated to the City supports the San Diego Police Department
(SDPD) and the Office of Homeland Security (OHS) by providing the means to enhance their
preparedness, prevention, and response capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the SDPD will purchase equipment to strengthen its capabilities in respect
to interoperable communications, law enforcement investigations, and laboratory processes and
testing; and

WHEREAS, the OHS will enhance its catastrophic incident response capabilities by improving voice and data communications systems within the Emergency Operations Center (EOC), and by providing emergency training events and exercises to increase EOC staff skills and proficiencies; and

WHEREAS, the DHS provides SHSP funds through the California Emergency Management Agency, which grants them to the County of San Diego Office of Emergency Services, which in turn sub-grants funds to the City; and

WHEREAS, there is no non-federal match or cost share required for the SHSP grant covered by this resolution; and

WHEREAS, this grant is reimbursable in nature, requiring the City to expend funds prior to requesting reimbursement; and


WHEREAS, expenditures will be initially sourced from the City's General Fund, and then reimbursed from the federal FY 2012 SHSP grant program; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor, Chief Operating Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Fire-Rescue Chief, or the Office of Homeland Security Program Manager is authorized, as the City's authorized agent, to apply for, accept, appropriate, and expend up to \$379,856 in FY 2012 State Homeland Security Grant Program funding from the California Emergency Management Agency via the County of San Diego Office of Emergency Services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, Chief Operating Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Fire-Rescue Chief, or the Office of Homeland Security Program Manager is also authorized to

execute all agreements necessary to comply with the FY 2012 State Homeland Security Grant Program requirements.
