A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INCREASING AND EXPENDING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDING FOR THE CITY HEIGHTS SQUARE MINI PARK PROJECT.

WHEREAS, in December 2008, the design and construction of the City Heights Square Mini-Park was funded by redevelopment bond proceeds to the City; and

WHEREAS, in February 2011, the Council by Resolution No. R-306557 authorized the acceptance of redevelopment funds for this project; and

WHEREAS, in order to complete the City Heights Square Mini-Park, additional funds from redevelopment bond proceeds were approved to include right of way improvements as part of the park project; and

WHEREAS, subsequently and before the project could be completed, the State cancelled redevelopment project funding; and

WHEREAS, in the event the State does not approve the redevelopment bond expenditure the funds would be transferred from the capital improvement program funds authorized for this project; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That in accordance with the annual appropriation ordinance, the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to amend the Fiscal Year 2013 Capital Improvements Program budget to increase CIP S-01070, City Heights Square Mini Park, by the amount of \$200,000.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to transfer the amount of \$200,000 from Fund No. 400109, Mid-City Special Park Fund, to CIP S-01070, City Heights Square Mini Park.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$200,000 from CIP S-01070, City Heights Square Mini Park, for construction of the project.
